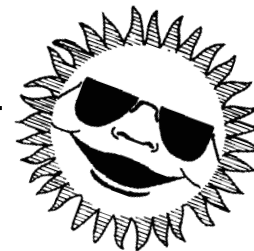

WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART

A true Master Mason of Freemasonry – Part III

Mozart’s interest in the Craft may have increased due to the highly visible philanthropy of the Masonic Lodge Zur Wohltitigkeit (Beneficence) whose 32 members raised over \$80,000 to aid flood victims following a natural disaster which struck the area. He was ‘initiated’ into this lodge in 1784, and was ‘passed and raised’ in early 1785.

Shortly thereafter Wolfgang brought his father, Leopold, into the Craft. For Leopold’s 2nd degree, Mozart composed a special song, “Fellow Craft Journey K.468” which was to begin a long series of Masonic compositions for Lodge ceremonies, concerts, and funerals. Among these compositions was a complete cantata, “The Little Masonic Cantata K/623”, the last work Mozart was known to have completed prior to his death.

There were opening and closing odes; songs about Brotherhood; and the hauntingly beautiful “Masonic Funeral Music K.477”, dedicated to two famous Lodge Brothers, and performed for a Lodge memorial service.

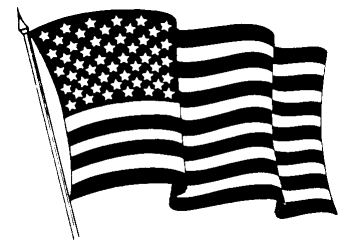

Knowing that many documentaries have been made over the sixty plus years since the end of WWII, Bro. Beckman researched extensively to make ‘a work of art’ that would cause people to sit down, watch it, and be in awe.

Besides interviews with Holocaust survivors as has been the ‘norm’ in the past, Bro. Beckman utilized photos,

documents, and artifacts. He narrowed his final product down to eight survivors who related unbelievable history and stories of what happened. One of his subjects is our own, Helen Marks, wife of Bro. Lloyd ‘Bob’ Marks and mother of Bro. Joshua.

The documentary is scheduled to be shown at the Capitol Theatre at Gordon Square on the West Side, and at the Cedar Lee Theatre in Cleveland Heights. We wish Bro. Beckman every success in this very important undertaking.
