Interested in a Night at the Races?

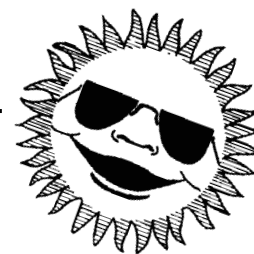

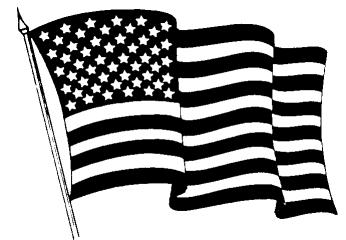

WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART

A True Master Mason of Freemasonry

Almost two hundred and forty years ago, in 1771, two monumental creations appeared which have withstood the test of time, and which remain today, as mesh and relevant as when they were first conceived. In both –, the content and spirit of the works reflected concern for the ennoblement of the individual, and were attempts by their creators to insure the future of the institutions they represented.

The Bill of Rights, formulated by a dedicated group of men, some of them Freemasons, guaranteed the basic rights of U.S. citizens, and protected them against the intrusions of the state.

Die Zauberflote (The Magic Flute) by Bro. Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was an operatic attempt by both composer and librettist (Bro. Emmanuel Schikaneder – 1751-1812) to convey to the general public, through allegory, the noble ideas of Freemasonry, and thus save the Craft from certain eradication by the political authorities in Vienna.

The response to our “Scots and Freemasonry” series (a form of Lodge education) has prompted a new series beginning with the above introduction.
