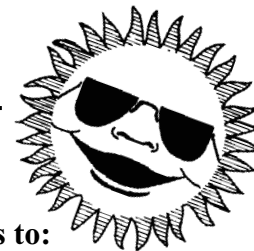

MUSINGS FROM THE WEST

The other day, a fellow Mason asked me, “Do you think I’m intelligent?”. The thoughts and subsequent discussion that occurred in response to this question prompted me to do some research about the nature of intelligence, and finally to write this article in order to communicate this knowledge.

Although many of us see intelligence as it relates to a number on an IQ test, this score only measures a limited subset of a person’s abilities. In more general terms, intelligence can be seen as the ability to adapt to a new or changing environment; to acquire and store knowledge; to reason and think in abstract terms; to understand relationships; and to produce something of value utilizing that intelligence. The number we see on an IQ test, like a credit score, is only a predictor, an indicator of the potential of a person’s intelligence, not a guarantee.

According to psychologist and author, Howard Gardner, there are nine types of intelligence, and each of us has a varying degree of competence in each. Normally, no one person is strong in all of these intelligent varieties, but often a person that we might consider as a role model will be competent in a few of these. Conversely we may meet a person highly gifted in one particular type of intelligence, but severely lacking in all the others, such as the late Kim Peek who inspired the film, “Rain Man”. Perhaps you can see yourself or some of your friends among these nine types of intelligence; I think I can attach a face to more than one of them.

1. Naturalist intelligence (“Nature Smart”) – ie: a farmer, zoologist, or explorer.

2. Musical intelligence (“Music Smart”) – ie: a musician, composer, or singer.

3. Logical-mathematical intelligence (“Number/Reasoning Smart”) – ie: scientist, mathematician, or even a detective.

4. Existential intelligence (“Mind-delving Smart”) – ie: clergyman or psychiatrist.

5. Interpersonal intelligence (“People Smart”) – ie: teachers, actors, or politicians. P.S. Good and smart Masonic leaders have this vital trait.

6. Bodily-kinesthetic intelligence (“Body Smart”) – ie: athletes, dancers, or pianists.

7. Linguistic intelligence (“Word Smart”) – ie: public speakers, poets, or novelists.

8. Intra-personal intelligence (“Self Smart”) – ie: psychologists or philosophers.

9. Spatial intelligence (“Picture Smart”) – ie: sculptor, architect, or even a sailor.

Masonry can help us work on several, if not all of these abilities, as we are charged to increase in knowledge and improve in social intercourse. I’m certain that each of us can think of at least one friend, acquaintance, or famous individual who is highly capable in one or more of these nine types of intelligence. Perhaps we can also evaluate ourselves by these scales, and decide if there might be areas in which we can improve, as well as intelligences which we possess that we might be capable of sharing with others.

SCOTS and FREEMASONRY

Robert the Bruce of Scotland

One year prior to the meeting between King Philip IV and Pope Clement V, where they plotted the destruction of the Knights Templar, Robert the Bruce (1274-1329), grandson of Robert Bruce, who had contended with John Balliol for the crown of Scotland in 1292, murdered his rival, John Comyn, in church in Dumfries in 1306. The Pope, who ordered the destruction of the Templars, excommunicated Robert the Bruce.

On June 24th, 1314, (The Feast of St. John), an English army under King Edward II, that had arrived to relieve Stirling Castle, was defeated by Robert the Bruce at Bannockburn. Legend has it that knights who appeared on horseback, in the flowing cassocks of the Templars, aided the Bruce in the defeat of the English cavalry. Edward II only narrowly escaped with his life, and to this day, the Battle of Bannockburn stands as the most single important military victory in all of Scottish history.

This ‘Battle’ occurred only seven years after the disappearance of the Templars and the Templar fleet.

Like the Templars, Robert the Bruce was under Papal proscription. Like the Templars, Robert the Bruce had been excommunicated. It has been said that, “the enemy of my enemy is my friend”, and there is no reason why the Bruce would not have welcomed the support of Warrior Knights who, like himself, were at odds with the Roman Church.

It is now believed that part of the Templar fleet sailed northward along the west coast of England, through the North Channel which separates Scotland from Ireland. They avoided Ireland which was firmly under the control of the Roman Church, and finally arrived north of Glasgow in Argyll, in the vicinity of the town of Oban. This is supported by the fact that Templar graves, marked with slabs of stones and bearing the outline of a Templar sword, are found in Argyll. Similar graves are found in the vicinity of Rosslyn, south of the City of Edinburgh.

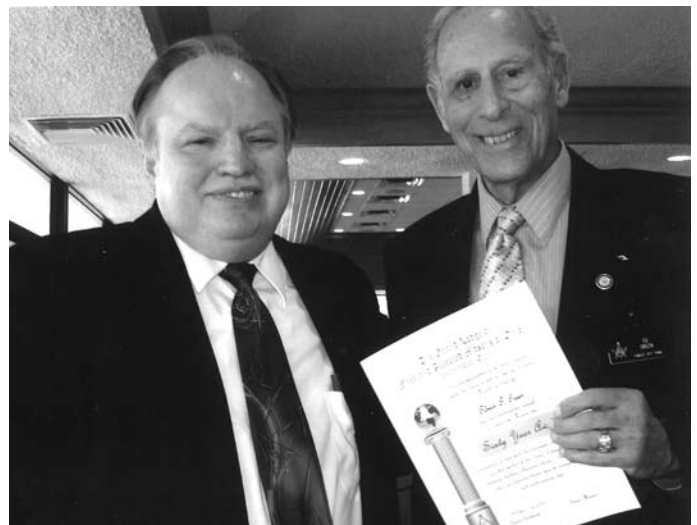

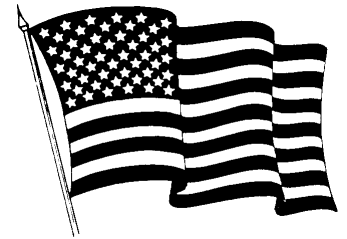
